Degrees conferred by IEERA University are subject to international authentication and legalization protocols, ensuring graduates' academic credentials can be authenticated for cross-border professional licensures, advanced university admissions, and international statutory requirements.

III. ACADEMIC GOVERNANCE & STANDARDS

Shared Governance & Academic Oversight

The University operates under a rigorous model of shared governance. Academic policies, curriculum design, and degree conferral standards are overseen by the Office of the Provost in consultation with the Faculty Senate, which comprises representatives from all eighteen constituent colleges. All degree requirements and institutional modifications are strictly validated through this collaborative oversight protocol.

Credit Systems & Degree Requirements

IEERA University adheres to the Carnegie Unit system, ensuring credit hour requirements meet U.S. Department of Education standards.

- Baccalaureate Degrees: Minimum 120 Credit Hours.
- Graduate Degrees: 36–54 Credit Hours.
- Doctoral Degrees: Minimum 60 Credit Hours beyond the Master’s level + Dissertation.



Global Credential Authentication & Legalization

All academic transcripts and degree diplomas issued by the Office of the Registrar are fully verifiable and eligible for international legalization procedures. Depending on the destination country's jurisdiction, graduates may process their university credentials for the **Hague Apostille (Apostille Convention)** or **Consular Legalization**, facilitating recognition for cross-border licensures, employment, and governmental evaluations.
